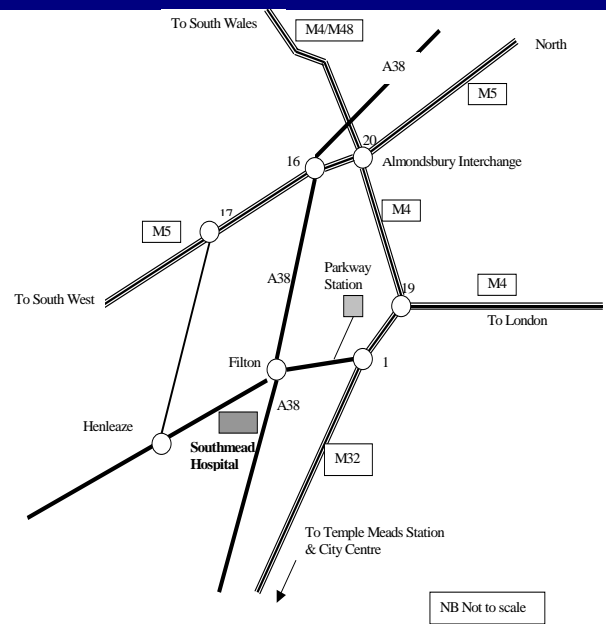

## How to get to Southmead Hospital



### By Motorway

Bristol is well served with excellent road links. The M4 and M5 put both London and Birmingham within a 2 hour drive and Cardiff can be reached in less than an hour over the Severn Bridge. The M32 links these motorways right into the centre of Bristol.

*From the M4 (from SOUTH WALES).* At the Almondsbury Interchange (Junction 20) join the M5 motorway and leave the M5 at Junction 16 - A38 to Bristol. \* Proceed along the A38, straight across the Aztec West roundabout and follow the signs to Filton. You will be on a dual carriageway and will pass Rolls Royce on your right. As you ascend Filton Hill you will pass Filton Technical College on your left. At the roundabout at the top of the hill, go straight over carrying on along the A38 – Gloucester Road North. Proceed for approximately ¼ mile and turn right at the traffic lights (Monks Park Avenue). The A&E entrance to the Hospital is approximately 250 yards beyond the traffic light, on the left hand side of the road

*From the M4 (from LONDON).* Leave the motorway at Junction 19 and this will take you on to the M32 (to Bristol). Leave the M32 at the A4174 (signposted Parkway). You will pass the Holiday Inn Hotel on your left. Proceed along the dual carriageway and go straight across at the roundabout (Sainsbury's on your right, MoD / MacDonald's on your left). Continue along the dual carriageway (Station Road) to the roundabout at the top of the hill. Go left at the roundabout onto the A38 Gloucester Road North. Proceed for approximately ¼ mile and turn right at the traffic lights (Monks Park Avenue). The A&E entrance to the Hospital is approximately 250 yards beyond the traffic lights, on the left hand side of the road.

*From the M5.* Leave the motorway at Junction 16 onto A38 – continue as \* for directions from the M4.

## By Train

The two main stations serving Bristol are Temple Meads in the centre of Bristol and Parkway on the city's northern outskirts. The journey from Temple Meads to Southmead Hospital (by taxi) should take between 25 and 35 minutes and from Parkway 10-15 minutes. From Temple Meads, you can take the number 54 bus going to Southmead/Cribbs Causeway (the stop is on the main road, on the opposite side from the foot of the station incline). You will need to get off at Doncaster Road, walk on along the main Southmead Road 100 yards or so and cross over to the main Hospital entrance.

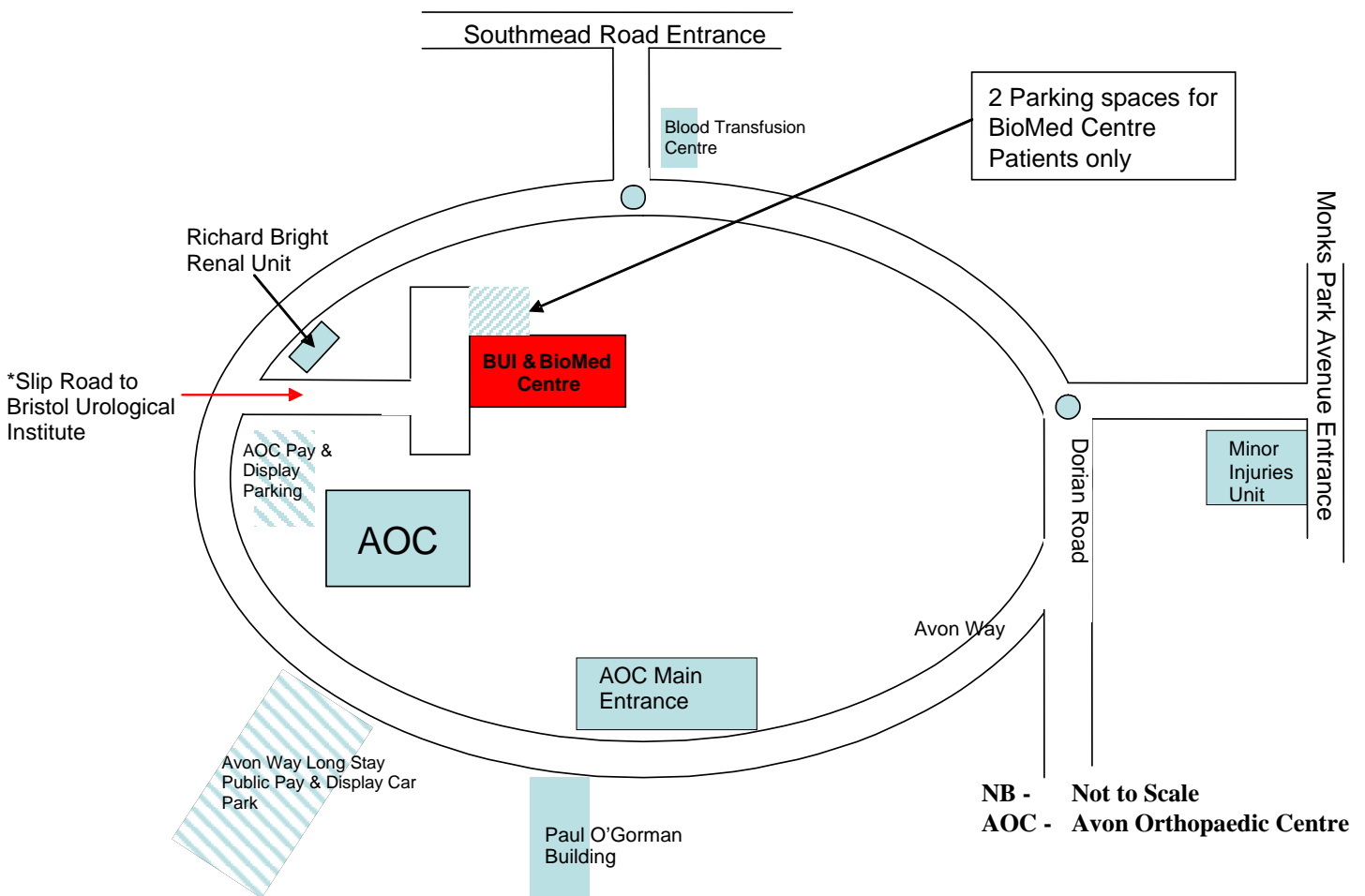
## Parking

The main parking is the Avon Way Long Stay Pay and Display Car Park. An alternative is the AOC Pay and Display Car Park which is marked below on the map but has fewer spaces available. The cost of parking is £6 per day however a weekly ticket is £10. The tickets can be purchased from the machine in the car park but please note the machines do not accept bank notes.

## Where to go next

To find the Bristol Urological Institute from the Avon Way Long Stay car park, turn left at the entrance barrier and follow the road round until there is a \*junction (marked Bristol Urological Institute). Turn right into junction and follow road to the end. The BUI building is situated to the left and the entrance is via the BioMed Centre. There is an intercom system here. Press the top button and you will be let in. The Bristol Urological Institute is situated on the top floor. From the Avon Orthopaedic Centre (AOC) Car Park you turn right and follow the road to the junction marked Bristol Urological Institute and follow the directions as above to the building.

A detailed map of Southmead Hospital follows on the next page, if viewing online, we recommend 400% zoom, the BUI building is located towards the bottom left of the map and number building 117.
